

Fox Chapel Marine Haul Out 2022 Instructions

In an attempt to simplify the haul out procedure, we have compiled a list of pointers that will facilitate the winterization process. Identification and Information

- Haul out request form must be filled out completely and legibly. Every blank must be filled in; date and signature are required, or the form will not be accepted.
- If your boat is on a trailer, please verify that it is marked with your name on the tongue or winch stand. **We require a 48-hour notice if you need your trailer pulled out for self-haul.**
- If you are hauling your boat out yourself, please indicate on form and mark winterization work desired. Please notify the boathouse when you pull your boat out and place it in the self-haul area of the yard.
- All customers that winterize their own boats must tag boat as winterized. This is to help us ensure that all boats in the yard are ready for the winter.
- Verify with the boathouse that they have your extra set of ignition and cabin keys, labeled with your name, and hanging in the correct place. **Please do not assume they are there.** If they are not there by your requested haul out date, you will be charged an additional \$100 fee and your haul out may be delayed until keys are produced. **No exceptions.**
- Please verify your boat will start. **You will be charged \$105 if we are required to jump start it.**

Dates and Scheduling

Due to high demand, we are requesting all forms to be returned by September 23, 2022. No verbal authorizations are permitted. Haul out reservations are **first come, first serve**. There is a limited number of boats that can be hauled out each week.

- All **PWC's** must be off of the docks by October 1, 2022.
- All **self-haul** boats must be off the docks by October 15, 2022, per your lease agreement. If your boat is still in after that date, it will be pulled, and you will be charged the unscheduled haul out rate.
- Please be advised that if you are one the last boats out in the fall you must be prepared and agree to be one of the first boats back in next spring. If your boat is not ready in the spring and we have to move it, you will be charged. **If your paperwork is not received promptly, we may have to pull your boat earlier than you wish.**

Any non-scheduled haul-out will be charged a fee of \$30.00/ft. LOA.

Boat Owner's Responsibilities

- All personal items (umbrellas, plants, hoses, fenders, etc.) must be removed from the dock before haul-out. If for any reason items are left behind, Fox Chapel Marine will remove and dispose of them. Items may be stored in a dock box which can be left on the dock, but the dock box must be secured to the dock. You run the risk of the dock overturning and your dock box will be submerged until spring FCM is not liable nor responsible for items left in dock boxes or on the dock.
- Remember to empty your refrigerator prior to haul out. Remove all food and liquids from the boat before covering boat for the winter. We are not responsible for removing these items.
- Boats in the yard will only be accessible during normal business hours. If you cover your boat with a tarp, please do not secure it to the stands. You are also responsible for any damage that your tarp causes to other boats.
- If you own your stands, you must drop them off at the marina no later than 1 week prior to your haul out date. If your stands are not found when your boat is pulled, FCM stands will be used and you will be charged the rental fee.

If you choose to do your own winterization, the use of regular ethylene glycol (green) antifreeze is not permitted. If we find this type of antifreeze in your cooling system at the time of launch, we will de-winterize the boat on land and you will be charged a disposal fee by law.
